On May 16, nearly 40,000 people ventured to the State Capitol complex in Des Moines to attend CelebrAsian: 2009 Asian Heritage Festival hosted by the lowa Asian Alliance. The State Data Center of lowa reports that the Asian-American population in lowa increased 26.1% between the years 2000 and 2007 and projects that growth to accelerate going forward. - The percentage of Asians/Asian-Americans in Iowa who hold graduate-level degrees is 27.4 percent versus 6.6 percent for all Iowans.
- In 2007, the median income for Asian/Asian-American households in Iowa was \$51,502 versus \$47,292 for all Iowans.







- Des Moines Police estimate 40,000 people were in attendance. This is an increase from 2007 & 2008.

- Nearly 40% of respondents have attended the festival 3 or more times
